



## Librex Newsletter - August 2014

Hi Marc-Andre,

Here's the August edition of our Librex Newsletter, which has the goal of keeping you informed about various Librex best practices and presenting you some of our new features.



### View The Links Between Your Configuration Elements

For Librex administrators, it can be difficult to have a complete understanding of the system configuration.

To help them, version 4 of Librex includes a tool to analyze and drill down the links between the different configuration elements.

All objects of type script, enumeration type, property and document model benefit from this new tool. In the administration window, after selecting one of those elements, a new button called "View Uses" is displayed. When selecting this option, you will see all places where this object is used.

For example, you could see that the "Customer Number" property is used in the "Work Order" and "Invoice" document models and that the "Employee Names"

enumeration type is used in the "Employee" property in the "Payslip" and "Work Contract" models. The usage mode is also detailed, indicating, for instance, that a property is used to name the document or is simply associated as metadata to the document.

This functionality will also help you clean your system, by helping you identify configuration elements that aren't used.

This server is available at [librexdemo.coriumsoft.com](http://librexdemo.coriumsoft.com) and requires a Librex client to connect to it. If you're interested, simply join us at [librex@coriumsoft.com](mailto:librex@coriumsoft.com) and we'll send you the link to download the Librex client. We'll also create a "user/password" that you may use to connect to it.

Please note that this is a shared test server that's regularly reinitialized. So please notify us if configuration elements must be kept in the system for your tests.
