Here's the July edition of our Librex Newsletter, which has the goal of keeping you informed about various Librex best practices and presenting you some of our new features.



Would You Like to Import Ready-To-Use Document Models?

Librex most recent version (3.16.0) includes a configuration exportation and importation tool.

Would you like to import document models built by another organization using Librex or from a test system? This tool allows you to export one or many document models (under the ".lbr_config" format). You may then import them into your own Librex instance.

This tool will also enable us to easily deliver new document models. We'll be able to design them into our infrastructure, and then send them to you so that you can import them into your own Librex system.

Also, we'll soon be releasing our new Librex support and documentation portal. We'll include in this portal a

collaboration space from where you'll be able to download for free different examples of document models.

To access this tool, go to Librex administration window, menu Tools, and choose the configuration exportation and importation options.



Use Barcodes!

Librex includes a free barcode reader that supports all major formats of barcodes.

Using barcodes on your standard company forms is a great way to facilitate data entry when scanning paper documents. Optical Character Recognition (OCR) success rates may vary depending on the quality and type of your paper documents, but barcode extraction will achieve an almost perfect success rate (except for some exceptions like a teared document).

A great practice is to adapt your ERP system to produce your documents with dynamic barcodes, including for example metadata like a customer number. But if you can't produce them dynamically, you can still add a static one where you'll put the identification of the document model. This way, you will have a quicker and more accurate forms recognition process.
