

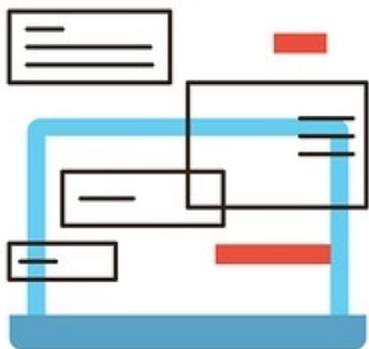

Here's the May edition of our Librex Newsletter, which has the goal of keeping you informed about various Librex best practices and presenting you some of our new features.



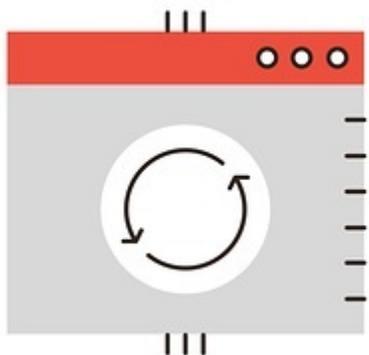
Structured Data Extraction Function

To extract data that follows a specific pattern of numbers, letters and other types of characters, regular expressions are the best allies of a software developer.

But for most users, it can be complex to build the regular expression that's tailored to the desired extraction.

To simplify this task, we've created a new structured data extraction function that enables you to define the structure of this targeted data using a simple and flexible user interface.

For example, the [following configuration](#) shows you how to extract a health insurance number that starts with four capital letters followed by eight numbers, with the third number being either 0, 1, 5 or 6 (being the first number of the birth month for a man, to which we add 50 for a woman).



Updates - Did You Know...?

Some customers are not aware of it, but in addition to the technical support by our team of Librex experts, our yearly maintenance plan also includes all new Librex releases. This means that you won't ever have to pay for a new Librex version and you'll benefit from all our future new features.

Also, you can generally install those updates by yourself in a few minutes using our simplified server installer (the Librex client application is updated automatically). And the update is downward compatible so, if a problem occurs, you can always go back to the former version. The exception is between major versions (from Librex 3 to 4, from 4 to 5...) for which it's recommended to first contact us at librex@coriumsoft.com to plan the update because some cleaning is sometimes done in those versions and scripts and configurations could have to be adjusted.
