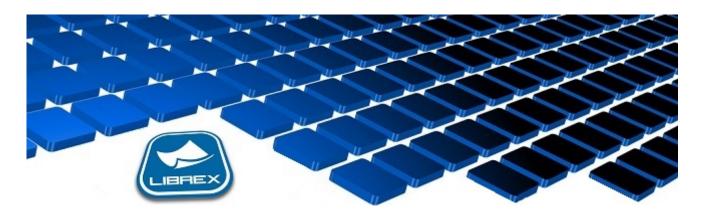

Here's the November edition of our Librex Newsletter, which has the goal of keeping you informed about various Librex best practices and presenting you some of our new features.



Folder Tree View in Capture

In the latest Librex releases, the sequential "Document List" in the capture window was replaced by a presentation using a folder tree view where you can visually identify all related documents for a specific customer/employee/supplier or other type of common folder.

If you scan or capture your documents folder by folder, you'll now be able to quickly and simply follow the progress of your operations and the volume or work achieved.

You'll also be able to minimize the view of validated folders to ease the display of your documents.

2D Text Search



For some documents' layout, the data to extract must be deducted from the position on the page relative to the localization of some other text.

For example, an invoice number can be located in a box under the keywords "Invoice Number". Or data in a table can depend on the header of the associated column.

In this context, the "Extract Rightwards/Downwards/Leftwards/Upwards From Keywords..." conversion function may become very useful.

This function enables you to define a reference text to search for and one or many direction(s) for your search. You may also define an accepted similarity percentage for your keywords or plug-in regular expressions.

While optical recognition tools generally return the extracted text in a long consecutive string, Librex offers the business logic layer that can analyze each data position in a two-dimensional space.
