### Users Tasks Permissions

Librex enables you to define tasks and assign them to users or groups. For example, after scanning an expense report, you can send an approbation task to a manager or to the accounting department.

In Librex's latest release, access permissions are now specific to each task and you can define a very fine granularity for each user's responsibilities.

You'll also notice that the "My Tasks" window is now accessible by all users from the dashboard, but that no task is available if nothing was assigned to them.

### Did You Know?

Librex is coded mostly in Java (version 8) and runs on a JBoss application server (Java EE).



Here are some benefits that Java procures to our customers and us:
