## New CMIS Connector

CMIS is a communication protocol enabling content management systems to interact. It's the common language for those often heterogeneous applications.

By providing a CMIS connector, Librex becomes compatible with a variety of new systems. Also, an external system that would like to integrate Librex as a capture tool would simply have to implement the protocol and the CMIS connector would be able to transfer content to that system (we're of course always available to support those partners).

This new connector can be completely configured through a user interface, so it's very easy to define how you would like your folders, documents and metadata to be distributed in the external CMIS system.



## Retrieve a Document History

To insure the legal value of a document, one of the important aspects is to be able to trace back its complete history.

Librex supports this very simply in the different windows where a document can be referenced, searched or consulted. A "History" button is available and gives you details about each and every Librex lifecycle step of the document, from its creation, to its modification, to its consultation, to its distribution and even to its eventual destruction.

Along with the power of the operations console, Librex enables you to audit your documents' lifecycle as well the operations and tasks executed by each user, giving you a 360 degrees view of what's happening in the system.

Tailored historic reports can also be generated if you would like to get more details on the operations for specific document types.
